

- d) Recommendation from a church leader who knows the candidate personally (Bishop, religious superior, national or diocesan communications coordinator, university rector, media director, or other leader in the local church) including a statement explaining as to why the candidate is particularly suited to work in the field of communication.
- e) Mutual commitment (signed by legal representative of the requesting institution and candidate) to engage the candidate in the communication ministry for at least three years; the statement should also:
 - Describe the staff development strategy and the organisational framework in which the candidate will work, and the media context (whether the church operates its own media and/or works with other church organisations in relation to communications, and perspectives towards the future).
- f) Confirmation from the Bishops' Conference (Bishop or national communication coordinator responsible for media and communication) or Superior, local Bishop, that the candidate's further training will be of benefit to the local church.
- **g) Confirmation** (or pre-inscription certificate) from the university/institute of the **candidate's admission** to the selected course/programme.

NB: The selection of the programme and institution or university should be based on the candidate's qualifications, experience, and future tasks.



BUDGET: For the presentation of the total budget, please use the attached form. In this budget the local contribution (from the candidate and/or their diocese or congregation) also needs to be specified.

International travel expenses and pocket money are in any case expected as a local contribution.
